The crest must be symmetrical from it commencement in the center of the head. The transition of the crest to the nape/neck must be smooth-feathered (close-fitting) without any trace of a crest. The "plain head" has a proportionately large head, slightly rounded and showing eyebrows. Grizzled and dark crests Body: Slim and elegant. The breast and the back are Plumage: Smooth and close-fitting to the body......10 pts Legs: Legs are fine, delicate and slightly flexed Condition: In a good health and clean. Uniform colour, yellow, red and white, buff and intensive.
