CREST: Large and wide in proportion with the robust size of the birdRounded from front to back and side to side. Crest well developed anduniform. Crest coming down well on the sides and finishing at the backof the head in a nicely tapered or hood like effect. Length not to extendbeyond the tip of the beak or obscure the eyes. Crest without splits,horns, or bare spots. Eyes bright and unobstructed. Beak shortFEATHERS - Neat, silky, smoothly follows the body contour.10 pts
WINGS - Evenly set, carried close to the body with the tips touching at the base of the tail. ..... 5 pts
TAIL - Short, compact, straight, carried rigidly ..... 5 pts
LEGS \& FEET - Neat, stocky, set well back, showing no thigh. ..... 5 pts
SIZE - Substantial, all parts in proportion, ideal length 6 inches. ..... 10 pts
GENERAL APPEARANCE - Alert, steady, clean and healthy. Nocobbiness or feather frilling. Stands at a 45 angle over the perch.Moves readily from perch to perch. Shown in Columbus Fancyshow cage.10 pts
